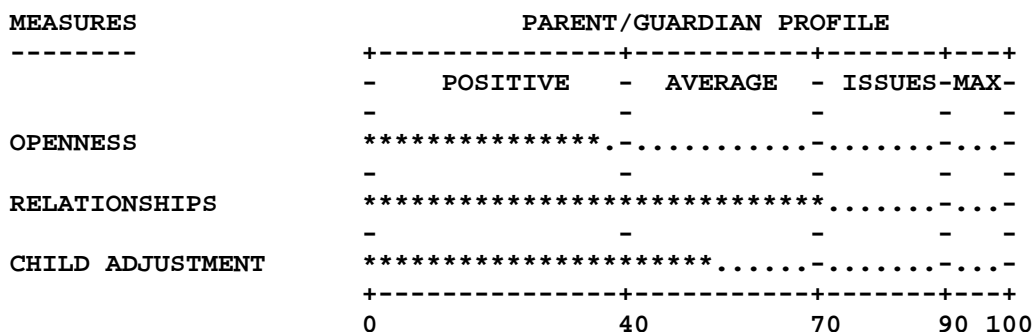


PARENT/GUARDIAN QUESTIONNAIRE

OPENNESS: This is an accurate Parent/Guardian Questionnaire Profile. This individual responded to questions in a cooperative, non-defensive and truthful manner. Denial and distortion is minimal. Adequate reading skills are evident and questionnaire results are accurate.

RELATIONSHIPS: Carefully review this parent/guardian's answers in the "family relationships" section (on page 1) of the Parent/Guardian Questionnaire report because they are problematic. Yet, these answers should help clarify topics of concern.

ADJUSTMENT: Involves a child's ability to adapt, conform and function problem free. This parent/guardian believes their child maintains an average adjustment in comparison to age peers.

SECTION 3 (Items 44-63). The answers listed under PGQ represent how the parent/guardian thought their child would have answered these items.
